Thank you for purchasing the BC-160 DESKTOP CHARGER. The BC-160 charges a Li-ion battery pack in approximately 1.5–3.5 hours.

Please read these instructions thoroughly before using the BC-160.

PRECAUTIONS


- ADANGER! Charge specified Icom battery packs only.
 The charger has been tested and approved for use with only genuine Icom battery packs. Fire and/or explosion may occur when trying to charge a third party or counterfeit battery pack.
- ADANGER! KEEP battery packs away from fire. Fire
 or heat may cause them to rupture or explode. Dispose of
 used battery packs in accordance with local regulations.
- MUSE INDOORS ONLY! NEVER expose the charger to rain, snow or any liquids.
- MARNING! NEVER disassemble the charger. Incorrect reassembly may result in a fire hazard or electric shock.
- **MARNING! NEVER** let metal, wire, and so on touch any internal parts of the charger.
- CAUTION: NEVER insert a battery pack or a transceiver (with the battery pack attached) in a wet or soiled condition into the charger. This may result in corrosion of the charger terminals or damage to the charger. The charger is not waterproof and water can easily get into it.
- CAUTION: NEVER use the charger when it is covered with objects that do not allow heat to escape.
- Place the charger in a secure place to avoid inadvertent use by children.
- **DO NOT** charge in conditions of extreme cold (under 0°C; +32°F) or extreme heat (over +45°C; +113°F). Battery packs may not charge under extreme temperatures.
- Keep the charger away from TV sets or radios to prevent interference.
- SAVE THIS INSTRUCTION SHEET. These instructions contain important safety and operating details for the BC-160.
- Make sure the battery and charger contacts are always clean, otherwise battery packs may not charge completely.
- If your battery packs seem to have no capacity even after being fully charged, charge them again. If they still do not retain a charge (or very little), purchase new one.

- The use of Icom transceivers with any equipment that is not manufactured or approved by Icom.


BATTERY PACK CHARGING

LED indication

Orange: Lights while rapid charging.
Green: Lights when charging is completed.

Red (blink): The inserted battery pack or the charger has

a problem.

When the LED indicator does not light, even after a battery pack is inserted properly, the battery pack may have a problem.
